WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMISSION; WE WILL ALSO EVICT UNDESIRABLES FROM THE CARAVAN PARK WITHOUT STIPULATING A REASON. The Lodge Trust reserves the right to close any feature without prior notice.

The Lodge Trust CIO will not be held responsible for any damage to client's property by fire, theft, accident, injury, etc, however incurred, whilst on our grounds. Members of your party are responsible for any damage or injury they cause to third parties and should have appropriate insurance covering them for this type of Rally. You may also be required to park your vehicles away from your pitches to protect the ground.

Please note, The Lodge Trust is a NO SMOKING site.

Rally Stewards are responsible for collecting payment, siting people, controlling inappropriate behaviour and being the first point of contact when any problems arise, therefore **the Steward must arrive before the rest of the party.** If you cannot be the first to arrive you must authorise another person to assume this responsibility and let us know this is the case and supply their details to us in advance.

Pitch Occupancy Occupancy from 1pm can be expected but NOT GUARANTEED. Please arrive before 9.30pm. Siting to be arranged by the Steward.

Units When on grass must normally be moved after a period of seven nights. No open fires, fire pits, chimeneas etc. BBQs must be off the ground & only use charcoal or gas (no wood, logs, kindling, etc). No paddling pools, water pistols, water balloons or water fights.

Children One person must be 18 years or over. Adults with children under the age of 17 are responsible for them and **must** accompany them at all times.

Clothes Lines Clothes lines are not allowed under any circumstances. They are dangerous at night and look unsightly. Please use window racks.

Dogs Dogs are welcome but att all times dogs must be kept on a lead in The Lodge Trust grounds. Owners must clear up after their dogs. We shall have no hesitation in asking offenders to leave The Lodge Trust if this is not done. **If you are not prepared to comply with these rules then please do not bring your dog.**
