
Getting Involved



Since 1984 The Lodge Trust has been providing Christian support for adults with learning disabilities, enabling them to have access to Christian resources and services as well as having choice and control over their lives. We are passionate about helping society at large to see that people can choose to have a faith and choose to be supported in developing that faith. Furthermore, local communities and churches can be equipped to help and support people with learning disabilities, fearfully and wonderfully made by God, who loves us.







Location

Market Overton is one of fifty attractive villages scattered throughout the rural county of Rutland. The village is in a peaceful setting and is six miles from the county town of Oakham and five miles north of Rutland Water.



We provide a variety of different styles of accommodation. There are small group houses (3-4 people), slightly larger group houses (5-6 people) and many individual flats. All of our residents have ensuite shower rooms and each house has its own garden as well as use of the 20 acres of shared space around site which is situated peacefully with beautiful countryside views.



Work and Education Service

We have both on- and off-site real-life work and education services for our residents and adults from the local community. Each individual knows their own interests and we help them to draw up their own work and education plan. We have real work opportunities such as woodwork, horticulture, crafts, catering and hospitality skills. We also provide a selection of ASDAN education courses covering a wide range of skills from hospitality to managing money, as well as courses aimed at assisting people to gain employment. We love our work as it gives us all a deep sense of achievement as we develop our skills and abilities.





The Lodge Trust Country Park is set in 10 acres of parkland and provides a café and shop, 2 holiday cabins, a Caravan Club Certified Location (CL) and a Caravan and Camping Club Site (CS). These facilities are open to the general public and also provide real work and education opportunities for our Service Users.



We are committed to enabling churches and small groups to become accessible to all. We can provide talks and seminars on how to make churches more accessible to people with learning disabilities and provide ongoing resources to small groups.



We have seen first-hand the impact that having a family member with learning disabilities can have on the whole family. We provide online forums and local coffee mornings for families to inform, support and encourage each other as they go through the different hurdles in life.
